

Welcome to SimpleWare Digital Media Services 1.2 Device Driver Software

UPGRADING WIRELESS USB NETWORK DEVICE DRIVER

For information on system requirements, installing, and launching SimpleWare 1.2, please read *Section 3, Installation* in your *User Guide*.

This document describes how to upgrade the wireless USB network device driver on Windows XP (the following procedure is similar for all of the supported operating systems - Windows 98SE, ME, 2000, and XP). To upgrade the device driver software:

- (1) Unzip file WDRIVER1.2.ZIP onto a floppy diskette.
- (2) Open the **Start** menu on your PC and select **Settings >> Control Panel**.
- (3) Click on the **Network and Internet Connections** icon.
- (4) Click on the **Network Connections** icon.
- (5) Double-click on the icon for the *Wireless Network Adapter*.
- (6) Click the **Properties** button.
- (7) Click the **Configure** button.
- (8) Click **Driver** tab. Then, click **Update driver** button.
- (9) Select **Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)** and click **Next** button.
- (10) Select **Don't search. I will choose the driver to install** and click **Next** button.
- (11) Click **Have Disk** and browse to the diskette drive containing the contents of WDRIVER1.2.ZIP. If you unzipped these files in another directory, browse to that directory. Then, click **Next** button.
- (12) Follow the instructions in the dialog boxes. When the new driver software for the USB wireless network adapter is installed, restart your PC.

Additional Instructions for SimpleWare 1.0, 1.1, and 1.11 Users

Upgrading your USB network device driver to this version modifies the adapter's **Network Id** to "simple". If you were running SimpleWare 1.0 to 1.11, you will need to reset the **Network Id** to the last three digits of the SimpleFi serial number, reset and rediscover your SimpleFi. For information on setting the **Network Id**, see *Appendix E* of your *SimpleWare 1.0 to 1.11 User Guide*. For information on resetting your SimpleFi, see pages 63 to 64 in *Appendix C* of the *SimpleWare 1.0 to 1.11 User Guide*. For information on rediscovering your SimpleFi, see page 18 of the *SimpleWare 1.0 to 1.11 User Guide*.

Now, download SimpleWare 1.2 from the Motorola SimpleFi Web site (www.simplefi.com). Install SimpleWare 1.2 over your existing SimpleWare 1.0 to 1.11 software, and rediscover your SimpleFi. SimpleWare 1.2 will then upgrade firmware running on SimpleFi.

Additional Instructions for SimpleWare 1.2 Users

Upgrading your USB network device driver to this version modifies the adapter's **Network Id** to "simple".

If your SimpleFi has already been upgraded to 1.2 firmware, your SimpleFi defaults to **Network Id** "simple", and you do not need to change your **Network Id**. If you changed your SimpleFi **Network Id** earlier, reset it to "simple". For information on setting the SimpleFi **Network Id**, see page 57 in the *SimpleWare 1.2 User Guide* (SimpleFi 1.0 to 1.11 users cannot set the SimpleFi **Network Id**).

If your SimpleFi has not been upgraded to 1.2 firmware, install SimpleWare 1.2 software and follow the procedure for SimpleWare 1.0 to 1.11 Users above. If your SimpleFi has been upgraded to 1.2 firmware, follow the discovery procedure described in either *User Guide*.
